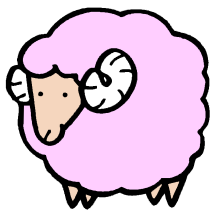

 - **Use correct and proper language at all times.**

Members £2.50, non members £3 per session. 3 for 2 offer at Ashton, pay for 2 sessions per week and the 3rd is FREE!

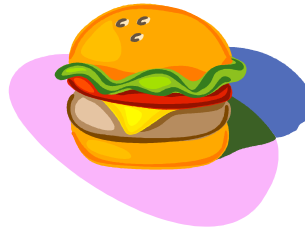

Licences

Under BJA (British Judo Association) rules, after 4 weeks all players MUST have a licence. For Under 8's this is a Kano licence, £15 per year, for over 8's & Seniors this either a full licence, from £19 juniors £26 Seniors.

A temporary licence £6 for 4 months, for juniors or £12 a year for Seniors can also be obtained, however you can not grade or compete with a temporary licence.
