Christmas party & awards evening

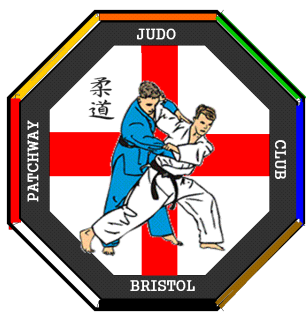

Grading and theory sheets

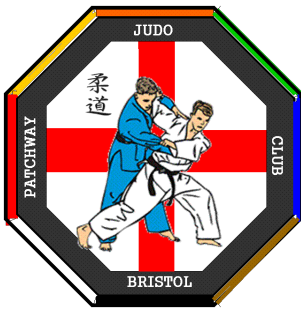
